Skills Block: Segment (break apart) and identify the syllables within words, and blend them back together.

Decode (read) and encode (write) words with different prefix and suffixes (e.g., *un-*, *re-*, *-ly*).

**Monday:** Writing about the Pollination Activity/writing Students used the labels to identify parts of a plant. From there I place glitter in brown paper bags that I glued the flowers onto. Students pretended they were bees picking up pollen (gold glitter) from each flower. They would then rub their pollen (Cheeto dust) fingers on the "sticky stigma" of another flower and "pollinate"
